A Volunteer's Perspective

Since 26th May 2011, a group of volunteers from SG Cares have been coming down every Thursday to conduct Bingo Session for our residents.

One of the volunteer, Nino, shares with us why he wanted to be a volunteer and his experience here so far.....

"In early 2012, I wanted to sign-up for KWSH's Bingo Session with the Elderly through SG Cares but had some hesitation as I couldn't speak and understand Chinese language or any dialects. However, I decided that I would be able to break the language barrier with a simple SMILE.

On the first day of volunteering at KWSH, I noticed that I was the only person who could not understand and speak any dialects which only fuelled my fear but I still kept smiling in an attempt to encourage myself. During the Bingo session, I could feel the joy and excitement radiating from the residents as well as the care and love of the volunteers towards the residents. It was akin to one big family playing in a reunion celebration. After the session, while pushing the residents in their wheelchairs back to their ward, I can feel their renewed energy and their smile is a reflection of their appreciative hearts.

Activities like the KWSH's Bingo Session is a manifestation that volunteering is work that comes from the heart - touching lives and bringing joy to both the volunteers and the beneficiaries. It knows no particular language, age, race and culture."

Q1: What made you choose Nursing in the ILTC sector as a career?

Sumi: Nursing is a challenging career for me. Through the knowledge I gained from managing patients with chronic illness, I can better care for my 2 elderly parents who suffer from chronic sickness as well.

Mary Rose: A career in nursing albeit challenging, is also inspiring as it makes a difference in people's lives.

Khin Mar & Devige: My passion of wanting to provide quality care for the residents inspired me to choose nursing as a career.

Q2: What is your daily routine like?

Sumi: Our routine involves keeping the residents as comfortable as possible. Bathing, feeding and changing the diapers of the elderly starts as early as 7am.

Devige/ Mary Rose: My daily routine consists of serving medications, assisting and supervising PCA's/HA's, doctor review and interacting with residents and sometimes, their family members as well.

Khin Mar: Oversee the daily operational needs of the wards under my care with regards to staffing as well as the residents' conditions etc.

Staff Wellness Committee

A Staff Wellness Committee comprising of representatives from across our organization was formed on 1 December 2012. The objective of this committee is to come up with wellness initiatives and to put them into actions. This dedicated committee will help to motivate staff by bringing about various exciting programmes that will benefit the staff.

Q3: What are the difficulties and challenges you face on the job?

Sumi: Communication is always an issue as most patients would speak in their own dialect. However, it is motivating when residents show you their gratitude when you are able to understand and attend to their requests.

Mary Rose: The environment, resident culture and language barriers are challenging to a me as a foreigner. In spite of these challenges, the good feedback that I receive from the residents and their relatives motivates me to always strive to do my best.

Devige: The challenge I face in a nursing home is assisting elderly residents with cognitive and physical impairments.

Khin Mar: Dealing with difficult customers can be challenging but my positive thinking and my residents' well-being keeps me motivated.

Q4: Can you share a most memorable experience at work during your time here in KWSH?

Sumi: Each time when a patient passes away, especially the ones who are close to us (nurses), we feel the pain of losing them as a bond was forged during the time they stayed here.

Devige: Seeing my resident's smile, receiving caring words from the relatives of patients as well as an understanding and caring management all play a part in forming a memorable experience for me here.

Khin Mar: Having been here for 16 years has allowed me to witness the changes in a decade moving from traditional care to the current resident management which is a memorable experience for me.

问:请问是什么原因驱使您选择护理工作为职业?
