4 Other highlight performances include the renowned Cantopop group Music In Law, alongside special guest appearances by versatile artiste Ms Mimi Choo and acclaimed opera performer Ms Qi Chao Qun. The audience thoroughly enjoyed the enchanting performances presented by these talented musicians, with a wide and diverse repertoire ranging from classic Cantonese opera arias to evergreen Cantonese popular songs.

5 KWSH Deputy Chairman, Mr Ng Siew Quan, announced the commencement of the project for KWSH's third nursing home at Miltonia (Yishun), which will be operational in 2028. He expressed heartfelt gratitude for the unwavering support and participation of all our donors, sponsors, and community partners in KWSH's future expansion plans to serve the community.

6 The night rose to a crescendo with the finale, when the Board of Directors came on stage to perform the evergreen hit 万水千山总是情, together with all the artistes and audience joining in the song.

Kwong Wai Shiu Hospital (KWSH) is a 113-year-old charitable healthcare organisation and is registered as an Institution of Public Character, committed to looking after the sick and needy. In the last century, it has continued the strong tradition of community service, having cared for many generations of Singaporeans, beginning its legacy in 1910 even before Singapore's independence. It is now one of the most established providers in the Intermediate and Long-Term Care (ILTC) sector.

At present, KWSH operates two nursing homes, six active ageing and care centres, two traditional Chinese medicine centres, a community training institute and offers home care services. Many of its patients are from the lower-income group and their fees are heavily subsidised.

To better serve the rapidly ageing population, KWSH had undergone a major redevelopment to house the largest single-site nursing home in Singapore and also transform itself into an integrated community healthcare hub, providing healthcare services to its residents and the community. With the official opening of its second nursing home in October 2022, KWSH is now one of the largest nursing home operators with close to 1,200 beds as well as expansion in its other services.
